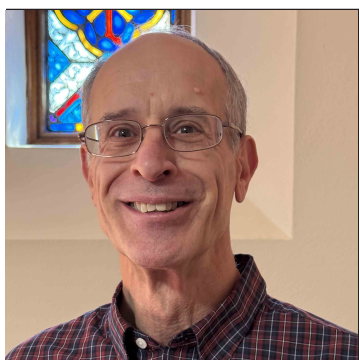
White Christmas Saturday, December 6, 2025
