

From the Minister of Children & Youth...

Summer is here! While for many this may mean long days at the pool or spending time in the garden, for the children & youth of our church it means that it is time for camp and Vacation Bible School (VBS). As I write this article, I just finished packing for kids camp. We will leave in the morning. I wish all of you could experience camp with the children. It is quite magical.

When we arrive at camp each child is given a passport (a small booklet that holds all the information they will need for the week). It has daily devotions, schedule, guided prayer activities, daily bible verses, group Bible studies, and even a scavenger hunt for the night market. The kids will enjoy a recreation party where they are guaranteed to get wet. They will meet friends from other churches in Bible Study Groups. They will get to choose free time activities, and we will have some pool time.

Camp is a lot of fun, but in my opinion the best part of camp is the way the children help lead worship. They read scripture. They pray. They create art that is displayed as part of worship. They carry in the Bible, cross, or candle. They do a dance to a particular song. Each child is given the opportunity to help lead worship in the way that they are most comfortable. While the children leading worship is my favorite part of camp, the night market is a close second. On the evening of the night market, the kids get to experience and learn more about the culture we have been hearing about. They will taste food, play games, hear music, and learn about a different culture. Camp is full of fun, but it is also full of worship, Bible study, & missions.

On June 25 the students will leave for their camp. They will also have times of intense Bible study, worship and free time. They will spend time with other students from various churches, compete in a volley-ball tournament, and get really muddy on an obstacle course. They will have the opportunity to zipline into the lake, fly through the air on the three man swing, or hangout on the ball courts. They will spend time twice each day climbing the infamous hill to chapel. They will enjoy skits, singing, testimonies of summer staff, Bible Study, and church devotions. This is a time where they not only learn more about God but they spend time connecting as a group and building the relationships that can last a lifetime.

Before we know it VBS will be here. I hope you plan to serve. We always need more helpers, especially adults! Our teens are great at leading groups, but we also need adults to be present to keep VBS a safe and fun experience for everyone.

As you think about this summer, pray for our children and teens. Pray that our times at camp will be safe and full of meaningful moments in which they draw closer to Christ and to each other. Pray for our travel to and from camp. Pray for the children that come to VBS, that we will show them the love of Christ.
