From the Pastor...

In our Wednesday night study of Revelation, we recently looked at the commendations and condemnations the Spirit gave to the early churches. I asked what God might be pleased with about our church, and where might God have word of warning for us.

There were plenty of strengths identified and a few suggestions how we could strengthen First Baptist Church. We will be working on those as we continue in our Spiritual Discernment/Visioning process. Someone then turned the question on me.

They asked, "Pastor, what's something you see good in our church?" GENEROSITY was my immediate reply. Our church is generous in so many ways. You give to the needs of our ministries, and you give substantially to community, state and world-wide ministries. You give of your time, talents and treasure.

Two recent events reminded me of your generosity. First, our congregation met and exceeded our 2024-25 Ministry Budget! Our budget was \$979,484 and you surpassed it by giving \$1,005,291 toward budget between October 1, 2024, and September 30, 2025.

On top of this, you gave an additional \$16,208 toward Alms and another \$102,603 towards designated causes. On top of this, you've started out our new budget year with a strong first Sunday offering of \$17,107. I have every confidence we can meet our needs in 2025-26, like we did in 2024-25.

Second, your generosity to Valerie and me on our 10th Anniversary with the church was amazing. We are so grateful for all the sweet cards and expressions of gratitude. You overwhelmed us with your generosity, and we felt very loved!

Thank you especially to the Campbell Johnson Foundation and the congregation for the gift certificate to The Grove Park Inn. We have never had this opportunity and look forward to taking some time to relax in the year ahead. Your generosity is inspiring!


